On 8 September 2025, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, 13 participants made their Act of Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary, concluding a 33-day preparation journey spread over three months.

The consecration took place during the 6 pm weekday Mass at the Church of St Teresa, presided over by Fr. JJ Fenelon.

As part of the consecration act, each participant lit their consecration candle from the Paschal candle's flame. This symbolic act reminded everyone that through this consecration, they renewed their baptismal promises and gave themselves entirely to Jesus through Mary.

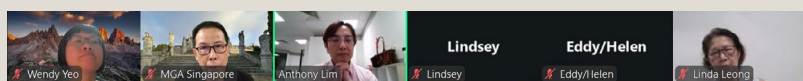




A Share in Mary's Faith

In The Footsteps of Montfort

At the Basilica of St. Louis Marie de Montfort @ St. Laurent-sur-Sèvre, we come upon Montfort, Mother Mary and Jesus above the stairwell leading to a crypt. The crypt was finally converted into a chapel in dedication to Montfort's beatification.

To Jesus thru Mary, the central tenet of Montfort's spiritual work, True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary came to life for me upon seeing them.

In this image, Mary is seen looking loving at Jesus. And yet from a different angle (not captured here), Mary seems to look back at Montfort, reflecting her love for Christ and Christ love for him, as Montfort looks on at her with love.

It brought to mind Montfort's writing in SM #56: "...She causes Jesus to live continuously in that soul and that soul to live in continuous union with Jesus. If Jesus is equally the fruit of Mary for each individual soul as for all souls in general, he is even more especially her fruit and her masterpiece in the soul where she is present."

As MGAs, let's continue to strive and live the sanctifying interior practices Montfort writes about in TD #257:

"...doing everything THROUGH Mary, WITH Mary, IN Mary, and FOR Mary, in order to do it more perfectly through Jesus, with Jesus, In Jesus and for Jesus."



Mary The Mystical Rose

St. Louis Marie de Montfort described Mary as the perfect creation of God, scented with the sweet fragrance of Jesus and honoured by the title "Mystical Rose". Montfort believed that Mary was pure and immaculate, therefore she could be the perfect Mould of Jesus. Just as Mary was called to form Jesus in her womb, we must form Mary in our hearts, so that we may bring forth Jesus in our lives. Inspired by these teachings, MGA, in collaboration with Montfort Centre, hosted an afternoon dedicated to prayer, reflection, and the creative act of sculpting clay roses in honour of Mary, trusting that each lovingly offered rose will be received, perfected, and presented to Jesus by our Blessed Mother.
